EIGHT TYPES OF MEMBERS!

Active Member

A graduate from an accredited dental hygiene program, licensed to practice dental hygiene in the U.S. Full dues and is a voting member of CDHA.

Student Member

A student enrolled in an accredited DH program, or a licensed DH returning to school enrolled in courses of study complimentary to the dental hygiene profession. Non voting member.

Supporting Member

A licensed DH who is not employed in a dental hygiene related position. 50% ADHA/CDHA/Component dues. Non voting member.

Allied Member

Not a licensed dental hygienist but an individual who supports the mission and goals of our Association. 50% ADHA/CDHA/Component dues. Non voting member.

International Member

A U.S. licensed DH practicing outside the U.S. Non-voting member.

Retired Member

An Active member 62 years of age with either 20 consecutive years of membership or 25 cumulative years of continuous membership from the date of eligibility. 25% ADHA dues, 50% CDHA/Component dues. Non voting member.

Disability Member

An Active member who is prohibited from being employed due to disability. 25% ADHA dues, 50% CDHA/Component dues. Non voting member.

Life Member

A voting member in good standing who has made outstanding contributions with a minimum of 20 consecutive CDHA membership or 25 years active CDHA membership. The component Trustee may nominate, and the BOT may recommend candidate for this membership by the House of Delegates. Voting member.
